## WE OFFER 6 OPTIONS

1. **Help to obtain Federal Student Aid and Enroll in community colleges or 4 years-colleges including online courses in GED and many other courses.**

2. **Vocational training in partnership with Apprenticeship programs/WorkSource. ICATCH (Health Care career), and Adult Culinary Art (Cooking).**

This job training will include Pay, College Credits, Certification, and Job Placement services.

3. **If you do not want level 1 or 2, we can help you through Dept. of Vocational Rehabilitation for vocational skill training.**

4. **For those unable to compete the above 3 levels, we can offer an individualized literacy program.**

5. **We help those who are in trouble with the law to pursue college education in partnership with Next Step Programs.**

6. We offer **temporary housing** (tents) for single homeless students.

### **MISSION STATEMENT**

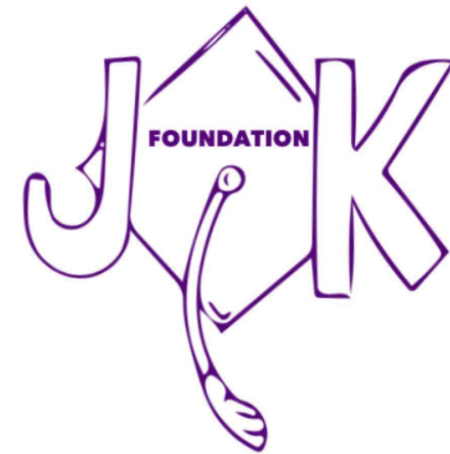
